The Temporary Competition Fee includes 13% HST. (a TEMPORARY COMPETITION FEE must accompany the entry when a dog is eligible for, but does not possess a CKC individual Registration number or an Event Registration Number (ERN) or Performance Event Number (PEN) or for Foreign born Miniature Dachshunds under one year of age). Note: Breeds of dogs on the Miscellaneous List cannot be entered as TCN eg. BC's

ENTRIES

- ◆ All dogs must be individually registered with the CKC, have a PEN, an ERN, A Canine Companion Number, or be eligible for Registration with the CKC, or have a CKC miscellaneous Class Certification Number. The dog must be at least 18 months of age, may be spayed or neutered. The dog may not be lame or compete if it is taped or bandaged. A dog can only be entered once in any one class in a trial.
- ◆ The entry form must be completed in every respect.
- ◆ No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- ◆ The tendering of a dishonoured (NSF) cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence subject to disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
- ◆ Any telephone calls required to confirm information will be made COLLECT.
- ◆ Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog/s regardless of how or by whom the entries were made
- ◆ Fax or Phone entries will not be accepted.
- ◆ If because of riots, civil disturbances or acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- ◆ All entry confirmation and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
- ◆ **Performance Event Numbers:** A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in agility trials (and other CKC competitive events that are appropriate for the breed). Eligibility: In order for a dog to be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met:
 - The dog must be of a breed recognized by CKC
 - The dog, for one reason or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration
 - The dog must be spayed or neutered
 - The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (this requirement is not necessary for ILP dogs).
 - The dog cannot be on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List (Miscellaneous Class dogs are not eligible to participate in the PEN program)
 - In the case of a foreign born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC ILP number.

- ◆ **Event Registration Numbers:** All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with payment (check with the CKC for the current fee). This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC Event. Please forward your request to The Canadian Kennel Club, Shows and Trials Division, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9.
- ◆ **Canine Companion Numbers:** Effective July 1, 2014, the CKC accepts mixed-breed dogs into its' Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience trials. If you have questions or concerns, please contact Membership Services at information@ckc.ca.

CONTACT FAMILIARIZATION FOR NOVICE DOGS

- ◆ Contact familiarization will not be available.

MOVE-UPS

- ◆ A dog earning a title after the closing date may advance to a higher level providing the Trial Secretary is notified no later than Monday August 16th, at 5:00pm.
- ◆ Move-ups will be permitted at the end of the day on Saturday (for the following day) and dogs may move from Excellent to Master Excellent between classes, however no other move ups will be permitted between classes on the same day.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ◆ The precinct of the trials shall be the area inside each of the rings and the specific area set aside for the judges and trial officials.
- ◆ No toys that make a squeaking sound are permitted within 15ft of the ring.
- ◆ Course Familiarization: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of each class. There will be a 3 to 5 minute break between the end of the walk-through and the first dog on the line.
- ◆ A Warm-up jump will be provided in proximity to the ring area.
- ◆ Only dogs entered for competition will be permitted in the precinct of the trials.
- ◆ The trials will be held outside on a grass surface. Two rings will be used. One ring is 100' x 120' and the other is 100' x 150'. The footing is grass. The fencing around the rings is 2" x 4" metal corn crib fencing that is 4' high. Ring gates are 4' x 5' metal chainlink fence gates.
- ◆ Trials will proceed rain or shine. No cover will be provided.
- ◆ No provisions have been made for rain or sun. Bring your chair and protection from the weather for yourself and your dog.
- ◆ Please do not litter. Use the designated area for your dog, then clean up.
- ◆ Dogs must be under control at all times and kept on a leash except in the warm up area and on the course.

- ◆ No food or other training devices will be allowed on the course. The dog may wear a well-fitted plain buckle collar, quick release collar or no collar, on the course (note: no tags or decorations are permitted on the collar).
- ◆ Competitors participate at this event at their own risk. The release on the entry form must be signed.
- ◆ All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- ◆ Electronic Timers will be used in both rings.

The Ottawa Valley Golden Retriever Club and the Ottawa Valley Poodle Club reserve the right to refuse entries, subject to CKC rules.

Exhibitor Information

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations Effective January 1, 2020, a copy of which may be obtained by calling the Central Order Desk of CKC at 1-800-250-8040

- ◆ A Frame is set at 5' for dogs jumping 12" or less and for the Steeplechase class and 5'6" for other runs.
- ◆ The Tire is set 4" less than the regular jump height.
- ◆ Broad Jump and Wall Jump will not be used.
- ◆ Electronic Timing will be used in both rings.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Payment of entry fees:

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

ALTERNATE LIST, REFUNDS

- ◆ **No entries may be altered, cancelled or substituted after the entry limit has been reached, or after the closing date, whichever comes first.**
- ◆ In the event that the entry limit is reached before the official closing date, an Alternate List will be compiled in the order received. Alternate dogs will be allowed to run in the place of any absent dogs. Alternate dogs which are not able to run shall have the entry fees refunded.
- ◆ There shall be no refunds in the event that the dog is absent on the day of the trial, or if the dog/handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event of inclement weather, other than as provided for below.
- ◆ Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has been submitted, a full refund will be made on receipt of a veterinary certificate prior to the day of the trial, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial.
- ◆ If a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured before a 3 day period preceding the trial, must **reach** the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial.
- ◆ To ensure the Trial Secretary has received the refund request in time the request, and Veterinarians certificate, must be received by the trial secretary no later than 9pm on Friday August 20th.
- ◆ A \$20 administrative fee will be withheld from all refunds.

OBSTACLES

- ◆ Agility obstacles meet the requirements of the CKC Agility Rules
- ◆ Note: A-Frame, Dogwalk, Teeter and Table have rubber surfaces and the Tire is a breakaway self healing type.
- ◆ There will be no required position on the table and the count will be continuous.
- ◆ Six weave poles are in all Novice Classes.
- ◆ One bar jumps may be used at any level.

CONDUCT

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

TRACKING FEE - Non CKC Member Canadian Resident

Effective January 1, 2011 the CKC instituted a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. In order to protect any points and awards earned at any CKC event, a resident non-member can choose to become a CKC member or pay the tracking fee as noted in the CKC fee schedule for each dog. Failure to comply with 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members resident in Canada and does not apply to U.S. exhibitors nor to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

JUMP HEIGHTS

All measurements are "at the withers"
 8 in for dogs 10" and under
 12 in for dogs over 10" up to and including 14"
 16 in for dogs over 14" up to and including 18"
 20 in for dogs over 18" up to and including 22"
 24 in for dogs over 22"

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

Dogs entered in the Selected division will jump one height lower than the above jump heights.

Dogs 7 years or older may be entered into the Veterans division at one OR two heights lower than their Regular jump height.

LEVELS

- ◆ Agility Novice: Open to dogs that have not earned the Agility Novice Title and those dogs who have acquired the Agility Novice title, but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Intermediate title.
- ◆ Agility Intermediate: Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and those dogs who have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.
- ◆ Agility Excellent: Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.
- ◆ Agility Master Excellent: Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.

DIVISIONS

- ◆ Regular – dogs jump height is as per standard rules
- ◆ Selected – dogs jump one height lower than standard rules
- ◆ Veterans – dogs jump one OR two heights lower than standard rules (handlers choice)
- ◆ The owner of a dog may choose to enter the Selected or Veteran Divisions in lieu of entering the Regular division but may be entered in only one division in a trial. A dog entered in the Selected division may enter the Regular division at a separate trial.
- ◆ Dogs entered into Veterans may NOT move back into Regular or Selected.

AGILITY TITLES (Standard)

AG.N. – Agility Novice

AG.I. – Agility Intermediate

AG.X. – Agility Excellent

Dogs must receive 3 qualifying scores of 85 points or better (out of a possible 100) from at least 2 different judges.

AG.M.X. – Agility Master Excellent

Dogs must earn 10 perfect scores of 100 in the Excellent Master class at 10 Agility Trials.

Note: Titles for Selected include an “S” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.N.S.) Titles for Veterans include a “V” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.N.V.)

AGILITY TITLES (Jumpers with Weaves)

AG.N.J. – Agility Novice Jumper

AG.I.J. – Agility Intermediate Jumper

AG.X.J. – Agility Excellent Jumper

Dogs must receive 3 qualifying scores of 85 points or better (out of a possible 100) from at least 2 different judges.

AG.M.X.J. – Agility Master Excellent Jumper

Dogs must earn 10 perfect scores of 100 in the Excellent Master class at 10 Agility Trials.

Note: Titles for Selected include an “S” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.N.J.S.). Titles for Veterans include a “V” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.N.J.V.).

AGILITY TITLE (Champion)

AG.M.CH. – Agility Master Champion

Dogs must have received both the Agility Master Excellent and the Agility Master Excellent Jumpers title.

AGILITY TITLES (Points and Distance – PAD)

N.P. – Novice PAD

I.P. – Intermediate PAD

X.P. – Excellent PAD

Dogs must receive 3 qualifying scores from at least 2 different judges.

M.X.P – Master Excellent PAD

Dogs must earn 10 qualifying scores in the Master Excellent class under at least 2 different judges.

Note: Titles for Selected include an “S” at the end of the Title (e.g. N.P.S.). Titles for Veterans include a “V” at the end of the Title (e.g. N.P.V.).

AGILITY TITLES (Steeplechase)

AG.SC. – Agility Steeplechase Title (open to dogs in Novice, Intermediate and Excellent; all dogs compete together regardless of level).

Dogs must earn 10 qualifying scores in Steeplechase under at least 2 different judges.

AG.SC.X. - Excellent Steeplechase Title. Dogs must earn 25 qualifying scores in Steeplechase (15 additional to the AGSC Title) under at least 2 different judges.

Note: Titles for Selected include an “S” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.SC.S.). Titles for Veterans include a “V” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.SC.V.).

AGILITY TITLES (International Challenge Class)

I.C.A – International Challenge Title. Dog must earn 3 International Challenge Standard class qualifying scores of 100.

I.C.J. - International Challenge Jumpers Title: Dog must earn 3 International Challenge Jumpers class qualifying scores of 100.

I.C.A.X. - International Challenge Agility Excellent Title. Dog must earn an additional 10 International Challenge Standard class qualifying scores of 100 after the dog has earned I.C.A.

I.C.J.X - International Challenge Jumpers Excellent Title. Dog must earn an additional 10 International Challenge Jumpers class qualifying scores of 100 after the dog has earned I.C.J.

C.H.I.C.C – Champion International Challenge Class Title. Dog must have earned both the I.C.A.X and the I.C.J.X Titles.

AGILITY TITLES (Jumps & Tunnels)

J.T. - Jumps & Tunnels Title. Dog must earn 3 qualifying runs from two different judges.

J.T.X - Jumps & Tunnels Excellent Title. Dog must earn an additional 10 Jumps and Tunnels qualifying runs under two different judges after earning the J.T. Title.

J.T.X.2 - Jumps & Tunnels Excellent2 Title. Dog must earn an additional 20 qualifying runs under two different judges, after earning the J.T. Title.

GRAND MASTER CHAMPION TITLES (G.Ag.M.Ch)

The Grand Agility Master Champion recognizes dogs that show consistency and versatility across all classes of the CKC agility program. (section 8.20). The CKC will permit the use of the letters G. Ag.M.CH. signifying Grand Agility Master Champion title, to be used in connection with and before the name of each dog which has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter Provided. To be permitted to use Grand Agility Master Champion title a dog must earn the following number of qualifying scores:

- 50 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Standard Class
- 50 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Jumpers with Weaves Class
- 25 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Points and Distance Class
- 25 Qualifying scores in the Steeplechase Class

Selected and Veterans will earn a title with the letter S or V after the title. Qualifying scores previously earned in these classes will be used towards this title.

- From Carling, go west past Moodie Drive - under the train bridge - Dogz is the last driveway on the right before you get to the lights at Herzberg Road. Look for the Dogz sign.

AWARDS

- Placement rosettes will be provided for 1st place qualifying runs in all height groups, in all classes.
- Placement ribbons will be provided for 2nd to 4th place qualifying runs in all height groups, in all classes.
- All dogs with a qualifying score will be awarded a flat qualifying ribbon.
- All dogs earning a title will receive a Titling Rosette.

PRIZES

- A Competitor Armband Draw will be done each day of the trial, for a prize in honor of Pippin (donated by Leslie Cameron).
- A Workers Raffle will be done each day.
- A prize will be awarded for the Best Qualifying Run in each Class.

CKC Agility Rule Changes 2020

New Category

Senior Handlers and Handlers with Disability (Section 2.12)

- Senior handlers (65 years and over) and handlers with disability may request a modified course time or a modified points requirement (PAD) (see tables below).
- Proof of disability or age will not be requested by the host club. A handler must indicate on the entry form if entering as senior/disabled handler (check S/D box) to receive modified times/reduced number of points.
- The handler's dog shall be entered at its current competition jump height and category. (Time and points concession is for the handler)
- For Standard, JWW, Steeplechase and J&T, the score table will subtract the time prior to scoring the run, regardless of whether the dog was under the SCT for that division and category or not. (2.12.4)
- For PAD, the score table will add 3 points prior to scoring the run. (2.12.5)

Modified Course Times (More Time Allowed)

- Standard, JWW, Steeplechase, J&T
- If course is under 150 yards, subtract 5 seconds from dog's time. If course is 150 yards or more, subtract 10 seconds from dog's time.

Reduced Points Requirement for Pad

- Novice - 3 points less (add 3pts to dog's total)
- Intermediate - 3 points less (add 3pts to dog's total)
- Excellent/Master - 3 points less (add 3pts to dog's total)

New Class

For Fun Only (FFO)

- At the owner's discretion, dogs are able to run in For Fun Only (FFO) class in any category. The owner would be allowed to take their dog into the ring with a toy. Toys are allowed but the toy must be identified to the judge prior to entering the ring. A maximum course time of 60 seconds would be allotted.
- FFO entries must meet all eligibility rules as dogs running for Qualification. FFO runs may be allowed at the same or a lesser fee at the club's discretion.
- A handler may choose to enter a dog FFO in any class, in any trial, at any performance level and at any jump height. Obstacle repetition is permitted without dismissal. They are not allowed to enter the same class again for a qualifying run. Dogs must attempt to run the course as numbered and are under the same judging criteria as dogs that are running for qualification.

New Title

Grand Agility Master Champion (G.Ag.M.Ch)

The Grand Agility Master Champion recognizes dogs that show consistency and versatility across all classes of the CKC agility program. (section 8.20). The CKC will permit the use of the letters G. Ag.M.CH. signifying Grand Agility Master Champion title, to be used in connection with and before the name of each dog which has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter Provided. To be permitted to use Grand Agility Master Champion title a dog must earn the following number of qualifying scores:

- 50 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Standard Class
- 50 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Jumpers with Weaves Class
- 25 Qualifying scores in the Master Excellent Points and Distance Class
- 25 Qualifying scores in the Steeplechase Class

Selected and Veterans will earn a title with the letter S or V after the title. Qualifying scores previously earned in these classes will be used towards this title.

Miscellaneous

- Temporary Competition Number (TCN) used for dogs not registered with the CKC (replaces "Listed") (6.1.2)
- Entry clarification: handlers may opt to enter their dog to jump at a higher height than their measured height for all Regular classes (8.5.2)
- Height cutoff changes for dogs 11" and under. Dogs measuring 11' and under jump a Regular height of 8". The Selected/Veteran height will be 4" (8.5.1)
- A select list of breeds, or mixed breed dogs that resemble these breeds in relation to weight to shoulder height ratios, are permitted (but not required) to jump either ONE or TWO jump height(s) lower than the designated shoulder height when they show in the Selected division. (See rulebook 8.5.5 for list)
- No toys that make a squeaking sound are permitted within 15ft of the ring (9.1.1)
- Time from end of walkthrough to first dog may range from 3-5 minutes or if the first 3 dogs of a class are at gate wanting to start, judging may begin. (10.11.1)
- Time judging starts must be announced at the end of the walkthrough.
