










Here's a few "rules of etiquette" that we'd like you to know about while you're out on the field...

-  For dog and horse safety, please keep your dogs on leash at all times when outside of the training rings;
-  If you bring more than one dog to practice, you may only work one at a time – the other dog(s) must be either tied or crated while waiting their turn;
-  Please be respectful of other handlers that may be sharing the ring with you by keeping your dog under control as much as possible, either on or off leash depending on their ability;
-  When entering the training ring, be careful not to let any loose dogs escape ;
-  If at all possible, take your dog out of the ring if they have to relieve themselves – ensuring that they do this before class would be best. We don't want the scent to encourage other dogs to do the same, and it's also a good habit for the dogs to learn as you will be eliminated from your class (pardon the pun!) for doing so at an agility trial;

If an accident does occur, please stoop-n-scoop and/or saturate the area (or equipment) with the disinfectant solution available at the fields – or your water if the containers are not available;

-  Green Fees are for members enjoyment of all the Dogz facilities, including use of the training rings, off-leash play area and equipment when they are not being used for lessons. Equipment for the various sports is only intended for use by handlers that have training on that piece of equipment. Failure to comply to this request will be cause to have your Green Fees revoked – it only takes one incident on an unknown piece of equipment to cause months of training problems, or even injury;

-  You are more than welcome to bring a friend or family member to watch or help with set up, but they are not permitted to bring their own dogs to use the facility unless they first complete the form to purchase a day pass. If they wish to use the equipment during their day pass, they must have prior training in that sport;
-  The Off-Leash area is for the enjoyment of all Dogz students and Green Fees members\*. For safety reasons, aggressive dogs are not allowed in the off-leash area while other dogs are present. Your off-leash privileges will be revoked if your dog exhibits behavior that Dogz deems to be inappropriate;
-  Remember, dogs are to be supervised at all times while on the premises - there is a tie-down at the “bathroom”, so please bring your dog with you if you have to go!

**\* A Note on Dog Behavior...**

Not all dogs are as wonderful with other dogs as we would like them to be, but most of them can learn to “get along” well enough to take part in dog activities. If your dog has a behavior issue, whether it’s with other dogs or with people, please let us know. We’ll gladly work with you to help your dog overcome it so that class, practice and playtime will be enjoyable for everyone. Please respect other Dogz members by not putting your dog in a situation that you know will aggravate it (like being too close to another dog while on leash), and be respectful of dogs that are sensitive – this way everyone’s dogs can have a good time!
